

Report on 112th Birthday of Shri R Venkataraman ji from a tribal village in Jharkhand

Today on December 4th 2022, at Jai Jagat Apna Skool centre, the children of mostly tribal village Kani Kendra under Markachcho block in Koderma Dist. Jharkhand celebrated the 112th birth anniversary of the country's eighth President Shri Ramaswamy Venkataraman.

The gathering began with a prayer meeting followed by an Introduction to the children on Venkataraman ji by Ekta Parishad Social Worker Keshav Yadav on his biography and thoughts. He recalled that Venkataraman ji was born on 4th December 1910 in Rajamadam village of Thanjore Dist. of Madras Presidency. He was elected as an MP several times in his life and took part in India's Freedom Movement, played an active role in Quit India Movement and as a consequence sent to jail for two years by the British. He was a labour leader and raised the many issues of the workers in all forums in India and abroad. He kept raising his voice to get justice to the labourers and founded Labour Law Journal, which continues to be of great value in the justice of labour courts. He served as a Minister in Madras state and contributed to the state becoming an Industrial state; and also Minister in the central Government in Finance and Defence with distinction before becoming the Vice President in 1984 and President in 1987.
